
crichton Estate – dating from 1834 Elizabeth Crichton following a bequest from her late husband, started the development of a "lunatic asylum" with the building of the Crichton Hall. Throughout the development it was renowned for the quality and forward looking nature of its healthcare.

Burns House – the home where Robert Burns spent the last years of his life. The house retains much of its 18th century character and contains many relics of the poet.





Burns Mausoleum – the striking Grecian mausoleum in which Burns, his wife Jean and five of their family lie. Burns was originally buried in a modest grave in the kirkyard and in 1815 his remains were moved to the mausoleum.







Drumlanrig Castle – discover over 600 years of family history. Enjoy the many treasures on display from the world-renowned Buccleuch collection to the enormous cascading gardens.
